Limited Visibility

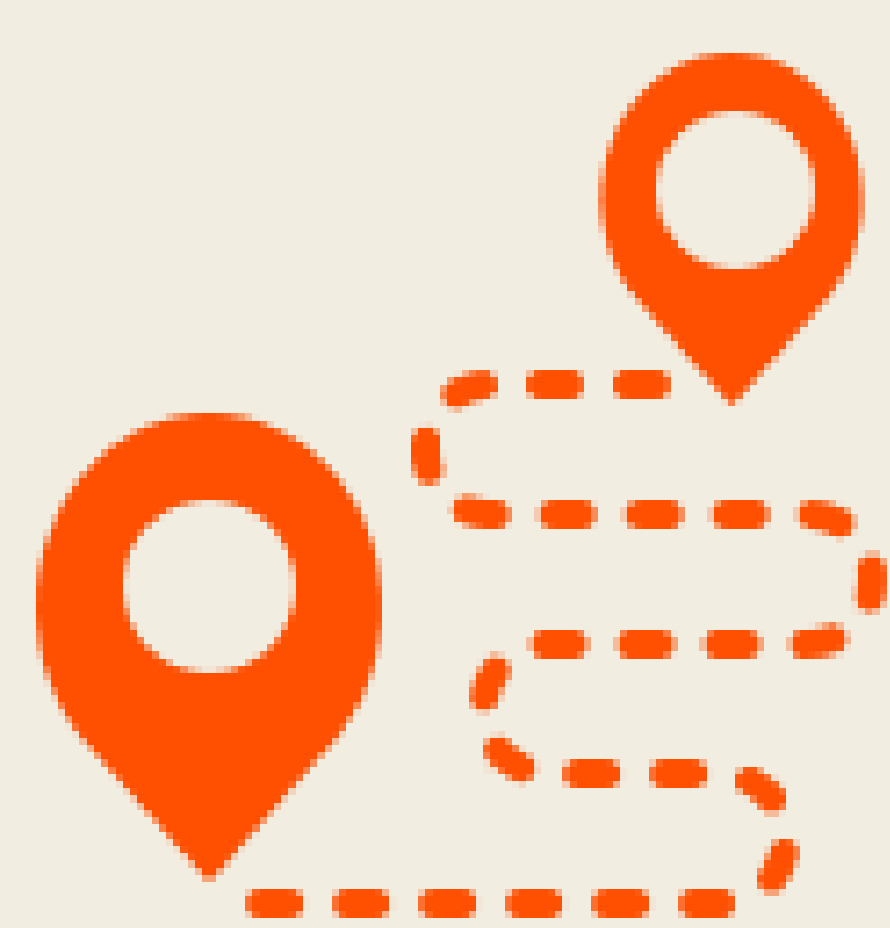
Without real-time tracking, it's impossible to know if a hauler is on time or delayed until it's too late.
